teacher:

Starting / finishing a lesson:

- Good morning, children / boys and girls / everybody!
- Please stand up / sit down.

Encouragement and discipline:

- Excellent!

- Let's play... bingo, line up, market place...!
- Let's sing a song!
- Put your worksheet into your folder. Put it into your schoolbag.

- Work with a partner / in groups of 3 / 4 / 5.

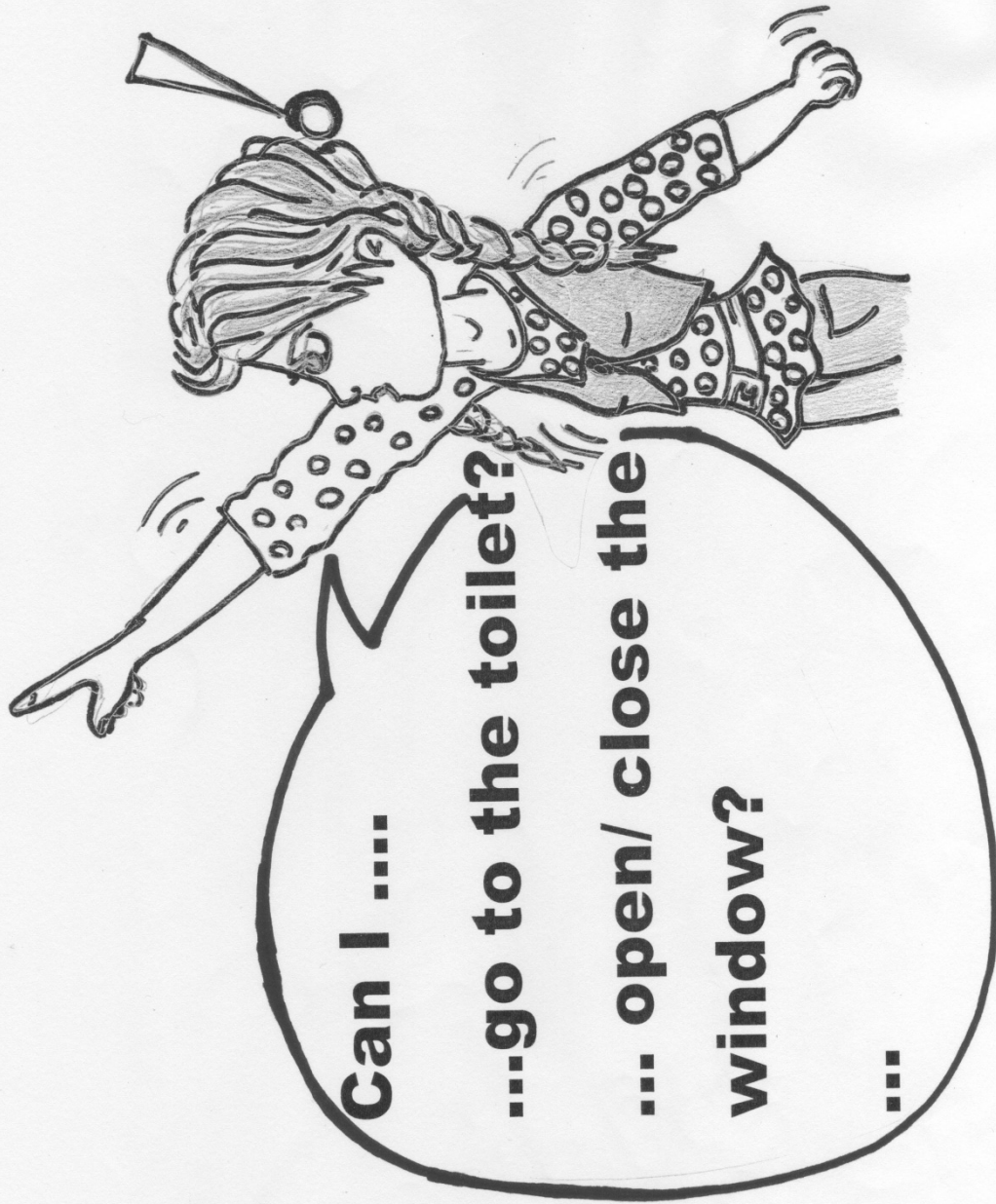
General classroom phrases
